#### LEADER'S GUIDE

#### ORIENTATION

Let's begin with the objective of this course, found on page 1. "The War" seeks

"to prepare believers to stand firm against the assaults from the demonic realm."

This study is meant to equip us to maintain our composure during our struggle with Satan and his forces. We will be learning both offensive and defensive maneuvers.

The primary figure in this course is not Satan. Our purpose is not to exalt a defeated foe. The primary Figure in this study is the One Who defeated Him, the Lord Jesus Christ. Our goal as believers is – as always – to exalt our victorious Savior.

You will find that this course has been constructed in such a way that it will alternate, back and forth, between truth that is very bright and truth that is dark:

On pages **6-8**, "The Reality of Spiritual Battle," we will become *oriented* to the war in which we fight.

Then on pages **9-40**, "A Profile of Our Enemy," the tone of our study will become *historical*, stretching all the way back into eternity past. We will watch as an individual rises to the pinnacle of privilege in the heavenlies, only to plummet – with his followers – to the pit of Hell.

On pages **41-54**, "The Assurance of Spiritual Victory," our study will have a *theological* bent as it outlines the different victories over Satan that Christ Jesus won on His own behalf – and ours – at His Crucifixion, His Resurrection, and His Exaltation to the right hand of the Father. Here, the tone of the course is filled with assurance and strength.

On pages **55-78**, with "The Tenacity (and) Tactics of the Demonic Realm," the course once again becomes sobering. Here, we will receive *counsel* to be on the alert to Satan's strategies.

Then, on pages **79-108**, "The Battle Gear of the Christian Warrior" and "The Battle Plan of the Triumphant Church," we turn once again to truth that is filled with hope as we consider in detail each piece of our armor and strategy to fully experience the triumphs our Savior has secured for us. The tone of this section is largely *practical*.

- ? What does that suggest regarding his original character? [His original character was "full of light": pure, spotless, blameless, in full fellowship with God.]

? What have we learned so far about the profile of this individual? [He is a creature with limitations. He is an angel. He held (and may still hold) the rank of cherub. He was created sinless. His titles were "Star of the morning" and "Son of the dawn." When he was created, he was flawless in moral perfection, strong in wisdom, and beautiful in appearance. And his status was exalted as (one of) the high-stationed guardians for God.]

# His Distinguished Stewardship in Heaven: "the Anointed Cherub"

? What does this section tell us about Satan's elevated status among the cherubim ... his special stewardship and Who entrusted that stewardship to him? [He was exalted above other cherubim as one who was "anointed" with great authority and power. He apparently was "the (only)" anointed cherub. It was God Who handed him this trust.]

? According to the author, when did "the anointed cherub" receive this second stewardship, "the ruler of this world"? [Sometime after the creation of this material universe but before his failed attempt to seize the throne of God.]

This stewardship gave him at least one right (and perhaps others).

? According to this section, what authority does this stewardship give him? [According to Matthew 4:8-9, "the ruler of this world" apparently has the right to place individuals in positions of political authority.]

? It was stated in this section that Satan "apparently has the right to place individuals in positions of political authority." How can that be true and Romans 13:1 be true at the same time? [Satan's authority over the nations cannot supersede the supreme authority of God. God, however, will sometimes use evil men (and governments) to accomplish His holy purposes (Genesis 50:15-21). To do so, God grants Satan permission to place evil men in positions of political authority.]

#### The Means by which He Received His Authority

This section concludes with the statement, "... the title, 'the ruler of this world,' was neither *self-appointed* nor was it *violently seized by a rebel*. It was *voluntarily granted to a trustworthy steward by the owner of the property.*"

? What support was given for this view? ["The star of the morning" received this authority from another party. He, therefore, was not acting alone. Nor could he have seized the world from the omnipotent Creator. The Greek word "paradidomi" carries the idea of a stewardship.]

# The Source of His Authority

But we do know that "the earth is the LORD's" and, therefore, it is His property to entrust to another. Furthermore, we know from the Scriptures that it was God Who had assigned him the position, "the anointed cherub."]

- ? If so, why do you think He chose him to have such authority? [(1) to provide both the angelic population and humanity with a choice between obedience and disobedience. He wants both to voluntarily follow Him or deliberately reject Him. And to do so, they must be faced with a choice. (2) Furthermore, the presence of sin allows God (Who seeks to fully display His perfections to His creation) to display His mercy, His grace, and His justice.] [already discussed]

? Can you think of any instances in the Bible where such assaults against God's people are traced back to demonic activity, yet result in the benefit of God's people? [(1) Job's growth in his knowledge of God was the result of Satanic attack (Job 1:6-19; 2:1-7; 42:1-6), (2) Israel's purification through divine discipline was the result of Satan inciting King David to violate God's will by take a census of the nation (compare 1<sup>st</sup> Chronicles 21:1 with 2<sup>nd</sup> Samuel 24:1, 10-17, 25), (3) The Apostle Paul's humbling and power was the result of "a messenger from Satan" sent to torment him (2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 12:7-10)]

# ? According to this verse, who establishes each nation's governing authorities? [God]

AND THE DRAGON (SATAN) STOOD ON THE SAND OF THE SEASHORE. THEN I SAW A BEAST (THE ANTICHRIST) COMING UP OUT OF THE SEA, HAVING TEN HORNS AND SEVEN HEADS, AND ON HIS HORNS WERE TEN DIADEMS, AND ON HIS HEADS WERE BLASPHEMOUS NAMES ...

AND THE DRAGON GAVE HIM **HIS** POWER AND **HIS** THRONE AND GREAT AUTHORITY ... AND THE WHOLE EARTH WAS AMAZED AND FOLLOWED AFTER THE BEAST; THEY WORSHIPED THE DRAGON BECAUSE HE GAVE **HIS** AUTHORITY TO THE BEAST; AND THEY WORSHIPED THE BEAST, SAYING, "WHO IS LIKE THE BEAST, AND WHO IS ABLE TO WAGE WAR WITH HIM?" (Revelation 13:1-4, parentheses added)

? According to this verse, who gives the antichrist his power and authority? [the dragon, *i.e., Satan*]

Our sovereign God allows Satan to appoint evil political figures to advance his *evil* purposes. In doing so, God's *holy* purposes are accomplished.

- ? What do you think is *Satan's* ultimate purpose in raising up evil governments? [that the nations will join him in his rebellion against God by submitting to his will and by bowing before him in worship]
- ? What is *God's* purpose in allowing "the ruler of this world" to raise up evil governments? How can they further God's will? [An evil government – unwittingly – forces a nation that is "gray" (morally) to become a nation that is "black and white." They do so by drawing a dividing line, forcing a separation between those who are righteous and those who are evil. Evil governments "separate the sheep from the goats."]

[They do so by placing those with a living faith in situations that force them to prove their faith (through obedience to God). By standing on the righteous side of the line, these will suffer at the hands of their government but will share in the glory of Christ throughout eternity.] [Those with a dead faith or no faith will prove their unbelief (through obedience to Satan). By standing on the evil side of the line, they may survive the tyranny of that government; but they become "ripe" for God's just judgment (Genesis 15:13-16).]

For the wrath of God is revealed from heaven against all ungodliness and unrighteousness of men who suppress the truth in unrighteousness, because that which is known about God is

EVIDENT WITHIN THEM; FOR GOD MADE IT EVIDENT TO THEM. FOR SINCE THE CREATION OF THE WORLD HIS INVISIBLE ATTRIBUTES, HIS ETERNAL POWER AND DIVINE NATURE, HAVE BEEN CLEARLY SEEN, BEING UNDERSTOOD THROUGH WHAT HAS BEEN MADE, SO THAT THEY ARE WITHOUT EXCUSE. FOR EVEN THOUGH THEY KNEW GOD, THEY DID NOT HONOR HIM AS GOD OR GIVE THANKS, BUT THEY BECAME FUTILE IN THEIR SPECULATIONS, AND THEIR FOOLISH HEART WAS DARKENED. PROFESSING TO BE WISE, THEY BECAME FOOLS, AND EXCHANGED THE GLORY OF THE INCORRUPTIBLE GOD FOR AN IMAGE IN THE FORM OF CORRUPTIBLE MAN AND OF BIRDS AND FOUR-FOOTED ANIMALS AND CRAWLING CREATURES. THEREFORE GOD GAVE THEM OVER IN THE LUSTS OF THEIR HEARTS TO IMPURITY, SO THAT THEIR BODIES WOULD BE DISHONORED AMONG THEM. FOR THEY EXCHANGED THE TRUTH OF GOD FOR A LIE, AND WORSHIPED AND SERVED THE CREATURE RATHER THAN THE CREATOR, WHO IS BLESSED FOREVER. AMEN. FOR THIS REASON GOD GAVE THEM OVER TO DEGRADING PASSIONS; FOR THEIR WOMEN EXCHANGED THE NATURAL FUNCTION FOR THAT WHICH IS UNNATURAL, AND IN THE SAME WAY ALSO THE MEN ABANDONED THE NATURAL FUNCTION OF THE WOMAN AND BURNED IN THEIR DESIRE TOWARD ONE ANOTHER, MEN WITH MEN COMMITTING INDECENT ACTS AND RECEIVING IN THEIR OWN PERSONS THE DUE PENALTY OF THEIR ERROR. AND JUST AS THEY DID NOT SEE FIT TO ACKNOWLEDGE GOD ANY LONGER, GOD GAVE THEM OVER TO A DEPRAVED MIND, TO DO THOSE THINGS WHICH ARE NOT PROPER, BEING FILLED WITH ALL UNRIGHTEOUSNESS, WICKEDNESS, GREED, EVIL; FULL OF ENVY, MURDER, STRIFE, DECEIT, MALICE; THEY ARE GOSSIPS, SLANDERERS, HATERS OF GOD, INSOLENT, ARROGANT, BOASTFUL, INVENTORS OF EVIL, DISOBEDIENT TO PARENTS, WITHOUT UNDERSTANDING, UNTRUSTWORTHY, UNLOVING, UNMERCIFUL; AND ALTHOUGH THEY KNOW THE ORDINANCE OF GOD, THAT THOSE WHO PRACTICE SUCH THINGS ARE WORTHY OF DEATH, THEY NOT ONLY DO THE SAME, BUT ALSO GIVE HEARTY APPROVAL TO THOSE WHO PRACTICE THEM. (ROMANS 1:18-32)

The LORD SAID TO SATAN, "HAVE YOU CONSIDERED MY SERVANT JOB? FOR THERE IS NO ONE LIKE HIM ON THE EARTH, A BLAMELESS AND UPRIGHT MAN, FEARING GOD AND TURNING AWAY FROM EVIL." THEN SATAN ANSWERED THE LORD, "DOES JOB FEAR GOD FOR NOTHING? HAVE YOU NOT MADE A HEDGE ABOUT HIM AND HIS HOUSE AND ALL THAT HE HAS, ON EVERY SIDE? YOU HAVE BLESSED THE WORK OF HIS HANDS, AND HIS POSSESSIONS HAVE INCREASED IN THE LAND. BUT PUT FORTH YOUR HAND NOW AND TOUCH ALL THAT HE HAS; HE WILL SURELY CURSE YOU TO YOUR FACE." (JOB 1:8-11) The LORD SAID TO SATAN, "HAVE YOU CONSIDERED MY SERVANT JOB? FOR THERE IS NO ONE LIKE HIM ON THE EARTH, A BLAMELESS AND UPRIGHT MAN FEARING GOD AND TURNING AWAY FROM EVIL. AND HE STILL HOLDS FAST HIS INTEGRITY, ALTHOUGH YOU INCITED ME AGAINST HIM TO RUIN HIM WITHOUT CAUSE." SATAN ANSWERED THE LORD AND SAID, "SKIN FOR SKIN! YES, ALL THAT A MAN HAS HE WILL GIVE FOR HIS LIFE. HOWEVER, PUT FORTH YOUR HAND NOW, AND TOUCH HIS BONE AND HIS FLESH; HE WILL CURSE YOU TO YOUR FACE." (JOB 2:3-5)

According to Job 1-2, Satan knew who Job was. He knew his name, and he knew his circumstances. It is likely that he also has this same information on you.

even *accomplish the purposes* of God. When we are experiencing demonic resistance, we should keep that in mind, that our sovereign God is in control of Satan's assaults.

[It would remind us that just because we are suffering does not mean that God has lost control of Satan and that this enemy is winning. We can have confidence in knowing that Christ will have the ultimate victory ... and we are on His side. We, too, will eventually be victorious.]

# A Warning

We have just finished a brief look at the "profile" of Satan. We discovered what his character and status were before his sin against God. We considered his attempted coup against the throne of God and the different stages of his judgment. We know that he has retained certain levels of authority within the angelic realm and over the world's political and religious authorities. And we have been oriented to his immoral character: he is a habitual sinner, a murderer, a liar, and an oppressor of the saints.

We have also been warned to "be ready for him, for the clash between our two forces is inevitable." Yet, in many cases the Church seems oblivious to spiritual war. You would think that if a church were being slammed by Satan, they would be trying to figure out what is happening to them and what they can do about it.

? Why are not more churches trying to understand how they can stand against the onslaughts of an evil creature? [Perhaps many churches do not experience the full brunt of Satan's assaults because they are no real threat to him. Because the lives of many church members are not guided by the Word of God or (consequently) empowered by the Spirit of God, they have not had to grapple with spiritual warfare. Yet, he seems to believe that he can thwart God's plans and purposes.

"One's level of spiritual discernment is determined – in part – by his level of Biblical understanding." Those who are unable to distinguish between truth and error will be an easy prey to the different heresies they encounter.

FOR THOUGH BY THIS **TIME** YOU OUGHT TO BE TEACHERS, YOU HAVE NEED AGAIN FOR SOMEONE TO TEACH YOU THE ELEMENTARY PRINCIPLES OF THE ORACLES OF GOD, AND YOU HAVE COME TO NEED MILK AND NOT SOLID FOOD. FOR EVERYONE WHO PARTAKES ONLY OF MILK IS NOT ACCUSTOMED TO **THE WORD OF RIGHTEOUSNESS**, FOR HE IS AN INFANT. BUT SOLID FOOD IS FOR THE MATURE, WHO BECAUSE OF **PRACTICE** HAVE THEIR SENSES TRAINED TO DISCERN GOOD AND EVIL. (HEBREWS 5:11-14)

? From this passage, can you see any other "ingredients" for being able to "discern good and evil"? ["the Word of righteousness," "time," and "practice" (obedience). To grow in discernment, one must practice the Word of righteousness over time.]

# Satan Seeks to Blind the Minds of Unbelievers

Some of the hardest people to reach with the Gospel are those who "grew up in church," those whose lives display a mere outward form of the Christian religion but who lack any real understanding of God's Word. They sit in their pews Sunday after Sunday; but "the light is not on."

[They have not responded in faith to the truth they hear week after week (even if it is only a little truth). Every time they dismiss God's Word, their minds become more hardened to His Truth, including the Gospel.]

# Satan Wants Us to Doubt God's Promises in the Bible

The only way to fight anxiety and despair is to dwell upon God's Truth. This would apply to the uncertainties of your situation. Not what do you *hope* He will do for you ... or what you think He *should* do for you ... or what *a Christian friend* thinks He should do for you. But what has *He* promised *in His Word* – written in black and white on the pages of Scripture – to do for you?

[Recall those promises you learned over the years in your study of the Scriptures. Every other authority under which they will ever live – teachers, policemen, employers, civil authorities, church leadership – will require them to observe certain laws, laws that have consequences if obeyed ... or disobeyed. Certainly, the supreme authority under Whom they will live is God; and He, too, has laws ... moral laws ... by which He expects them to abide. If they do, they will enjoy a blessing; if they do not, they will suffer a penalty.

? How does one teach the reality of consequences to another person? [By giving the promised consequence of blessing to the one who does what is right or the promised consequence of discipline to the one who does what is wrong.]

(2) He should study the Scriptures that he might "present himself approved to God as a workman who does not need to be ashamed, accurately handling the Word of Truth." (3) He should be

prepared to say, when asked a question he cannot answer, "I do not know all the answers to all your questions. But I do know that Jesus Christ is changing my life." (4) He should pray for "the composure of Christ" while facing such pressure.]

It is all just a big fake."]

# Satan Will Try to Weaken Our Sense of Dependence upon God by Cultivating an Attitude of Self-Reliance

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

Have you ever viewed yourself as "unfit" for a task to which God has called you? You are certain that someone else is more qualified for this ministry than you. You pray for confidence; but those prayers go unanswered. (You continue to feel unsure of yourself.)

? How could this sense of inadequacy be the very thing you need to succeed in this calling? [Without this sense of confidence, we tend to rely more upon ourselves and less upon God. He wants us to know that His "power is perfected in weakness."]

? Now let's look at the other side of the coin. Against what kind of temptations should we be on guard once we experience success? [The temptation of self-reliance. The temptation to take credit for the success ... to exalt ourselves rather than God]

#### Satan Will Use the Cravings of Our Physical Bodies to Entice Us to Disobey God

[Ask someone to read this section: page 70.]

"Comments, Questions, Clarifications?"

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

It is possible to use Satan's temptations as your "cue" to pray. For example, let's say that you often find yourself criticizing your pastor's sermons. Each time you realize you are doing so, turn those thoughts into a prayer. Ask the Lord to guide him in his sermon preparation and empower him in his preaching on Sundays. Satan will not continue to use that tactic once he sees that it produces righteous behavior in your life. He will "flee."

The fact is, we all struggle with some form of weakness. We all want to indulge ourselves in something to the point of excess. Therefore, it would be a good idea to come up with some plan of "counterattack." When I am tempted to give in to this sinful practice of my flesh, this is what I am going to pray.

### Satan Will Try to Dilute Our Zeal for Christ by the World's Pleasantries

[Ask several to read this section: pages 70-71.]

Believers who face trying situations that give them a strong sense of helplessness typically find themselves fervently pleading to God for deliverance.

It may be that one or more of you are facing a problem right now ... something that is troubling you. If so, perhaps you are willing to let us help you carry that burden through prayer. I hope you will. But it may be that you do not feel comfortable describing the situation to us.

? If not, would you be willing to tell us *something you know about the true and living God*, a truth you are clinging to – by faith – as you work through this situation? How can God, being the way He is, help you with this problem?

[Have someone read a verse that presents an attribute of God, qualifying Him to be the Solution to this problem.]

[Ask someone to pray that God would provide this brother or sister with the ability to focus on His character, enabling him or her to respond victoriously to this situation.]

# Using the Believer's Circumstances, "Satan" Will Disrupt Our Labor for the Kingdom in his Attempt to Resist God's Will

[Ask several to read this section: pages 75-76.]

"Comments, Questions, Clarifications?"

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

? What should be our first response when any of these disruptions happen? [We should acknowledge (through prayer) that our sovereign God has a purpose for allowing Satan to do this ... that His purposes are always good, meant to sanctify His people and (ultimately) bring honor to His Name ... that His purpose will be fulfilled in His timing ... and that His timing is always perfect. If our response is not of faith, then it will be a response of frustration or anxiety. (The better we know Him, the more we will trust Him.)]

### The Spiritual Significance of "Putting on the Breastplate of Righteousness"

[Ask several to read this section: pages 82-83.]

"Comments, Questions, Clarifications?"

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

- ? In your own words, what does it mean to "put on the breastplate of righteousness"? [By faith, the believer accepts as true that he has "become the righteousness of God" (2<sup>nd</sup> Corinthians 5:21). In doing so, he can remain secure in his salvation. Additionally, by trusting the Holy Spirit to empower him to live out the righteousness of God, his obedience will cause Satan to "flee" (James 4:7) and his soul to be strengthened.]
- ? How does a person "put on" the breastplate of righteousness? [Righteousness imputed: He must first trust in Jesus Christ to rescue him from the consequences of his sins (eternal death). Righteousness imparted: A daily reading of God's Word. A daily fellowship with the Lord through prayer. A resolve to trust the Spirit of God to provide everything we need to obey the will of the Father. Practical steps toward obedience. A separation from influences that lead to immorality or distraction from close communion with Christ.]

- ? In your own words, what does it mean to "shod your feet with the preparation of the Gospel of peace"? [To have confidence in God's steadfast support of him in his battle with the enemy. By faith, he knows that God is not against him but is, instead, at work on his behalf. It is to have confidence that "God is on my side!"]
- ? Why would that be important, for the Christian warrior to know that God is "on his side" ... especially in the heat of spiritual battle? [If God were **not** on his side, the outcome of his fight against a more powerful enemy would be certain defeat. Also, this belief would "steel" him with a commitment to persevere when the battle draws out longer and becomes more intense.]

[It is to submit to the good and sovereign purposes of God ... as the believer resists the devil's temptations ... obeys God ... and patiently endures the battle. It is to trust God to deliver one from defeat when he is attacked. (It does not mean to trust God to protect one from attack. God has not promised to do that.)]
- ? How does one cultivate this life of faith? [By hearing and reading the Word of God. By remembering the past works of God in his life. By learning from the testimonies of other believers as to how they trusted God to provide something they needed.]

THEREFORE, SINCE WE HAVE SO GREAT A CLOUD OF WITNESSES SURROUNDING US, LET US ALSO LAY ASIDE EVERY ENCUMBRANCE AND THE SIN WHICH SO EASILY ENTANGLES US, AND LET US RUN WITH ENDURANCE THE RACE THAT IS SET BEFORE US, FIXING OUR EYES ON JESUS, THE AUTHOR AND PERFECTER OF FAITH, WHO FOR THE JOY SET BEFORE HIM ENDURED THE CROSS, DESPISING THE SHAME, AND HAS SAT DOWN AT THE RIGHT HAND OF THE THRONE OF GOD. (HEBREWS 12:1-2)

To endure the shame and suffering of the Cross, Jesus "focused His faith" on His future exaltation to the right hand of God. We are then told to "fix our eyes on Jesus" (as our Example to follow) as we run our own "race of endurance."

? Why do we believers need to know that there is a "finish line" to this war we are in and that, like Jesus, we should "focus our faith" on our own day of glory? Why is that so important? [Weary believers need the encouragement of these guaranteed rewards to keep us strong in a battle that seems to have no end.]

# The Spiritual Significance of "Taking the Sword of the Spirit (the Word of God)"

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

It was stated, "Just as a physical battle requires physical weapons, a spiritual battle requires spiritual weapons."

Sometimes we may find ourselves trying to fight a "flesh and blood" enemy, at the moment we are attacked, using tit-for-tat insults. That is, we are trying to fight the wrong enemy, at the wrong time, in the wrong place, with the wrong weapons. Have you ever felt like that ... that you are in a battle, but you are handling it "all wrong"?

? How do you know whether you are trying to conduct a spiritual fight with spiritual battle gear ... or not? [One sure way is by honestly answering the question, "How much time do I spend in prayer?"]

# "Forging" the Spiritual Sword

#### The Role of the Holy Spirit in the Fight

He "shines His light" on the Scriptures, giving me the capacity to correctly interpret its God-intended meaning. He empowers me to apply God's Word to my life.]

# The Role of Bible Study in the Fight

"Comments, Questions, Clarifications?"

[Be sure to discuss each *issue* that is brought up.]

? We have seen what the Holy Spirit must do to turn His Word into a spiritual sword. What must you do to turn your physical Bible into a spiritual sword? [I must get to know the Word of God (by reading and studying It) before I can apply It to my life. Furthermore, Truth must be believed and applied before it becomes a spiritual weapon. When it is, that weapon will be too powerful for the demonic realm to stand against (James 4:7).]

[He is to embrace by faith – with unreserved confidence – the truths regarding each of his victories God has revealed to be true.]

- ? If someone said to you, "I would like to start reading the Bible; but I do not know where to begin," what would *you* tell him?
- ? How would you counsel him to continue in his reading once he is finished with that book of the Bible?

## QUOTE GOD'S WORD

[Have someone read Psalm 119:11.]

YOUR WORD I HAVE TREASURED IN MY HEART, THAT I MAY NOT SIN AGAINST YOU. (PSALM 119:11)

"treasured" (Hebrew, tsaw fan') – comes from a *root word* meaning "to hide" (by covering it over) ... "to hoard" something. Because of its value, the owner tries "to protect" it. This word means "to hide" or "to lay up" something (in a secret place) because of its esteemed value. That's why the King James Version translates this word "hidden."

We have been exhorted to respond to Satan's lies by quoting God's Truth – whether mentally or verbally – to ourselves and others. To do so, we need to "treasure" or "hide" God's Word in the "arsenals" of our minds.

? Can you think of any ways – either obvious and creative – to "hide" God's Word in our minds and hearts to prepare us for the battles we face?

# CLING TO GOD THROUGH PRAYER

? What guarantees does he not have? [an improvement in his circumstances]

### **OBEY GOD**

? Why would our obedience cause Satan to "flee"? [Perhaps one reason is because he sees that his efforts to cause us to stumble are having just the opposite effect. Perhaps his rapid departure is to prevent any further promotion of God's Name and kingdom.]
